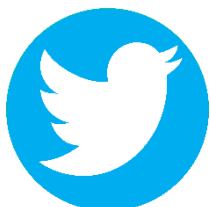

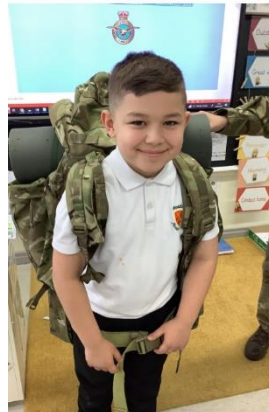
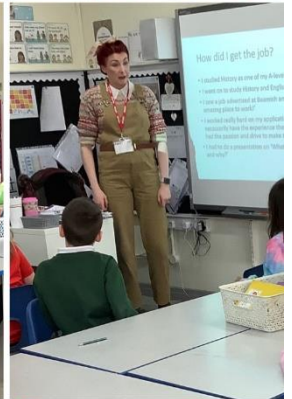
Dates for your diary...
