Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities

I have been recognised within the Local Authority, and Nationally, for the work that I have done in relation to supporting SEND children and have a track record of 'Outstanding' leadership in this area. Alongside other leaders in school, I will collectively oversee this essential area of the school until our new SENDCo can join us. As of April 2024, Mr. Daniel Ramshaw will join our team as the next SENDCo. We are aiming to secure time for him to come to Broadway in the next term to begin familiarising himself.



As it stands, our school day is staggered. A polite reminder that all children should be in class at **8.30am if they are in Year 3 and Year 5.** Any children in **Year 4 and Year 6 should be in their class by 8.40am.** Children in school complete important activities in class as soon as they arrive; therefore, any lateness impedes their chances of success in some lessons.
