School Achievements in 2023-2024

We have been inspected by Ofsted (October, 2023). We are a 'Good School'. We have committed thousands of pounds to ensure all year groups still attend at least 3 school trips across the year.

We were granted £10,000 to develop our school building – we have introduced a beautiful, new Library!

We have introduced a Wraparound for families who require this and have secured funding to maintain this moving forwards. We have enhanced our 'in school' offer where visitors regularly attend to enrich our curriculum. Pupils meet and experience a diverse offer.

We have lots of opportunities for families to come into school: Meet the Teacher, Coffee Mornings or Crafternoons, for example.

Attendance is above national averages for 23-24. We have reduced the numbers of pupils who miss school persistently.

We celebrate success as a school, weekly, and with lots of rewards available! We are Award Winning!

We have achieved a Quality Mark for Science, PE, Music, Computing amongst many more...

Y6 Maths results were the BEST that the school has seen in over 5 years – 81% of pupils achieved the 'expected standard' or above.

We DOUBLED the number of pupils who achieved FULL MARKS in Year 4's Multiplication Check. Our OPAL play initiative has improved provision for pupils – pupils have 15 more minutes per day to develop key, social skills.

Early Reading/Phonics has received a £6,000 investment. We have everything we need so pupils make a 'flying start'.

We maintain support via the Healthy Heads Team, allowing children to access mental health support within reduced timescales. We are a 'Problem Solving School' which recognises our commitment to providing everyone with essential maths skills.

Our Pupil Parliament is well established and our pupils have a voice for the change that they want to see at Broadway Junior School.

We support many charities, raising funds for great causes and we continue to be supported by Greggs to offer a FREE Breakfast Club!

We have a stable, longstanding, approachable staff team. Wellbeing is at the heart of everything we do, for everyone.

Our staff participate in quality professional development, accessing nationally recognised qualifications which lead to school improvement.
