

We will be taking part in 'Go All In' – The National Year of Reading campaign to get more people reading. Everyone knows reading expands worlds, sharpens minds, and fuels creativity. On World Book Day every primary school child will receive a World Book Day Book Token. These are redeemable in all major bookstores. The children can exchange their token for a World Book Day book; just look out for the special stickers. Your child will receive their book token from school, please put it to good use!

School will be holding a **Book Fair** for your children to buy some exciting new books from **Thursday 5th – Thursday 12th March 2026**. We welcome families to spend a few minutes looking through the book fair, you will be sure to find many books that are suited to your child. Book fair will be open from **3.00pm to 3.30pm** daily. I am sure you will agree that reading is of great importance and we really do appreciate all of your support. In return for your book purchases, school will receive free books for your children to read. Every book you buy earns commission for our school. We look forward to seeing you there. Don't forget you can use your special World Book Day Token to redeem £1 off any book at our Book Fair.

As a celebration of World Book Day, the children may come into school on **Thursday 5th March** dressed as a book character; this should be great fun! Children can also bring in their favourite book to share during the day.

We will also be running a Reading Competition over the two weeks running up to Book Fair. The children simply need to record what they have read and write a **Reading Recommendation** then return this to school to be in with a chance of winning a special book prize. Look out for our 'Go All In' Reading Competition Form which the children will bring home on the run up to half term.
