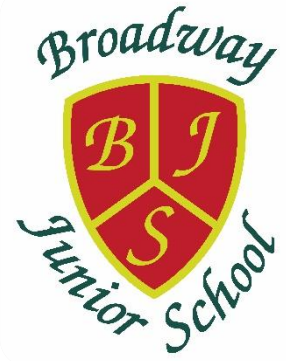

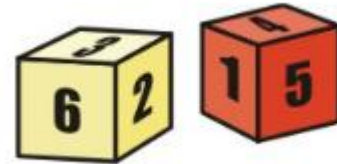

My Happy Mind

This half term's theme is 'Relate'

The **Relate module** focuses on **relationships and friendships**. The main aim is to help children understand **why positive relationships matter and how to build them**. It teaches the **building blocks of healthy relationships**, such as:

- Being a **good listener**
- Understanding **other people's feelings and perspectives**
- Learning how to **get along with others**
- Building **positive friendships**
- Solving small friendship problems in a healthy way

During this module, students usually practise: **Active listening, Empathy, Friendship skills and Handling disagreements**. It teaches children **how to understand other people and build good relationships**, which is an important part of being happy and mentally healthy.

School Security

During the half term holidays, we have made some improvements to our school's security systems and we have had cameras installed in key, external areas of the school. As a public building, it is not uncommon for schools to have CCTV installed and it has been a natural next step for us at Broadway Junior School so that we are up to speed.



Important: Management System Upgrades

In the coming months, we will be writing to you about a change in the way we will be working. Myself and our office team are making changes to our school's management system which will, with time, help you to see/update key information about your child/ren on an electronic system named Arbor. By making this change, we will be able to stream line our back office systems and allow you to engage with school life – all in one place! We will be transitioning carefully towards this meaning you will be able to make payments, book club spaces, update your own information (such as change of address etc.) and we will be able to email you directly, send text messages and monitor attendance amongst much more. We hope that this will help us move towards a paperless approach which will save us money and be more environmentally friendly too.

The visit provided a hands-on opportunity to connect classroom learning with the natural environment and helped deepen pupils' understanding of rivers, coasts, and local wildlife.
