We would like to share some information about **Pol-Ed**, an educational programme used in your child's school.

Pol-Ed is a free resource created by West Yorkshire Police and specialist teachers to support schools in delivering Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education. It provides age-appropriate lessons and assemblies that help children and young people understand how to stay safe, make positive choices, and develop important life skills.

The topics covered through Pol-Ed include areas such as:

- Online safety
- Healthy relationships
- Bullying
- Personal safety
- Understanding the law
- Making informed choices

All materials are written by experienced teachers, working in collaboration with the police, local authorities, and other partners, to ensure the information is accurate, relevant, and appropriate for children and young people.

Pol-Ed is designed to support schools in meeting statutory requirements for PSHE and Relationships and Health Education, while also responding to real issues affecting young people in local communities.

Lessons are delivered by school staff in a safe and supportive environment, where pupils are encouraged to ask questions, discuss ideas, and develop their understanding in a way that is appropriate to their age.
