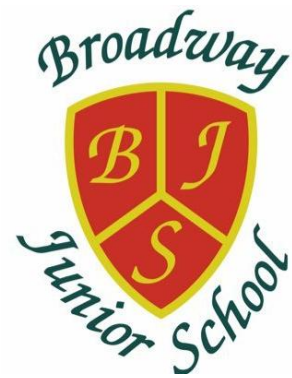

If you are unable to attend, information packs will be made available for you. We will make the same information available via our school website too.
- **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> June & Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2026**  
Y2 pupils will attend Broadway Junior School for two fun-filled days at our school. There will be plenty of opportunities to become used to our building and time to meet their new teachers who will be confirmed closer to the time. Familiar staff from Grindon Infant School will be on hand to help us at the end of the school day too.
- **Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2026 – Welcome Presentations**  
A session will be held at 2.15pm in our school hall where we will be able to share key information with you all about our school's organisation and policies. Your children can be collected at 3.00pm and you may tour our school. This will help you to prepare for your first day in September. The same session will be repeated at 5.00pm for families who cannot attend earlier sessions due to work commitments.
