

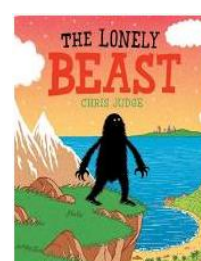
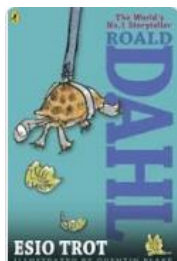
Termly Learning Leaflet

Reading

In order to reinforce learning, your child will be given a reading record book. Reading is exceptionally important and it is imperative that children are reading regularly, hopefully for 10 – 15 minutes at least 5 times per week. It would be really helpful if you could listen to your child read and record this in their home reading record. Reading records are to be returned every Monday morning. Children will bring a book home from school, but they are also quite welcome to read any books or magazines they have at home.

Homework Expectations at Broadway Junior School

Children will receive homework each Monday to be returned the following Monday. Homework may be set using an online platform such as Purple Mash, Sumdog or Times Tables Rock Stars. The work will be explained and discussed in class before coming home; it may be a continuation of classwork, or a task to consolidate learning. We would really appreciate your support in ensuring your child completes and returns their homework on time.

Our Curriculum in Year 3 this term...

In reading we will...
Explore a range of texts and the vocabulary used by the author to convey a character's appearance, thoughts and feelings.
In writing we will...
Write character and setting descriptions using expanded noun phrases. Retell a familiar story. Begin to use inverted commas to show when someone is speaking. Write a non-chronological report linked to an area of our curriculum.
In mathematics we will...
Add and subtract numbers which bridge across 10. Count and compare numbers to 1,000 and add and subtract within 1,000 using known facts. Measure and read scales using mm/cm, g/kg and ml/l. Make simple conversions between measurements e.g. 250cm = 2m 50cm. Identify right angles in a range of shapes. Learn the 10 and 5 times tables.
In science we will...
Identify animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition. Identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement. Observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and identify some magnetic materials. Describe magnets as having 2 poles. Predict whether 2 magnets will attract or repel.
In history we will...
Look at Stone Age society, animals, housing, food and inventions. Consider land use and areas of settlements including shifting continents. Study inventions from the Stone Age to Iron Age in Ancient Britain.
In geography we will...
We will learn the location and human/physical features Children will compare these new places with places they are familiar with. Getting to know our local area, including our school area.
In computing we will...
Internet safety: Lessons will help children understand how online identities work, how to connect with others safely, and the importance of privacy, trust, and kindness on the internet. Touch Typing and Branching Databases: Children develop typing speed and accuracy by learning correct posture, finger positioning, and safe computing habits. They also learn to organize and debug data by building branching databases using binary questions.
In RE we will...
Explore the Christian creation story as well as learning about the Festivals of Harvest, Advent and Christmas.
In art we will...
Mix and use paints to create prehistoric paintings linked to our stone age history topic.
In DT we will...
Investigate a range of packages used for different purposes. Design and make our own packaging using the skills of scoring, cutting, joining and strengthening.
In music we will...
Take part in weekly glockenspiel lessons with a music tutor learning basic rhythm and notation skills. Listen to and appraise a range of musical genres.
In PSHE/RSHE we will...
Learn how to keep ourselves safe near roads and online. Learn how to look after our physical and mental health. Learning what helps us feel safe and included.
