Within the comments received, families have also brought to our attention the things they'd like clarification on or the things they'd like us to work on next. We have summarised the key points which have been raised a number of times within this survey.

General Comment	School Response
Daily Mile	The Daily Mile is not a compulsory element of a school's practice. We have reflected on the current provision in place and have ensured that there is a wide range of sporting/active opportunities for children to engage in their exercise each day and across the week. We offer swimming sessions, PE lessons, active after school clubs and daily lunchtime clubs which are all paid for by school meaning this is open to all.
	Our staff team are further developing this offer and are putting plans in place to implement a timetable of active opportunities during lunchtimes which will rotate – all with purpose and clear organisation.
	Our school day is currently shorter than most and we need to work towards a 32.5 hour week, minimum, by September 2024. It has been essential that the current timetable remains broad and balanced meaning we have needed to prioritise other curriculum areas too. By removing the Daily Mile in its previous form, we have been able to ensure equality across the entire curriculum.
Dojo / Communication Apps	Since the school re-opened in September, we have implemented a Half Termly 'Welcome Back Letter' which helps to clarify key events in the coming weeks. Each month we share a Broadway Bulletin which summaries our key areas that month. We use a text messaging/email system to communicate more urgently. Our achievements, developments, promotions and school work is shared on social media via X (formally known as Twitter) via @broadwayjuniors – this is free to 'follow'. We have implemented a Termly Learning Leaflet which shares the key messages specific to your child's year group and have opened the school up for an initial Meet the Teacher Session.
	Our staff are always available to meet, on request, and we always endeavour to respond promptly to queries. We feel we have a wide range of communication approaches in place.
	Moving forward, we have commissioned the development of a new school website which, soon, will come with an App version allowing you to use a mobile device easily so you can navigate around the information that we upload. We hope that this further supports/helps when it is live.
Wrap Around	School currently provides a free Breakfast Club and free after school clubs until 4.00pm. We would consider, moving forward, exploring parents' interest in Wraparound but this would need to be financially viable for us to run.
Water – Hydration Stations	Children's access to water is not restricted in the school day. Now, water bottles are stored in all classrooms in a specific area – known as a Hydration Station. This has helped minimise any disruption caused within lessons (e.g. spillages or tripping on bottles within the classroom, for example).
	This has been a small change in school and nobody is disadvantaged by it.

Swimming /	We plan to ensure that our curriculum enhancements remain varied, regular (at least termly) and at minimal cost to you as a family.
Visits & Visitors	Unfortunately, finances do not always allow for us to maintain some of the school's previous offers – such as swimming for all classes in
	all year groups, every year. Last year, the bus to the Aquatic Centre alone was almost £12,000 with each swimming lesson, on top,
	costing around £95 per week. When a visit is booked, coaches now cost us around £500. Factoring in the cost of the entrance fees, we
	subsidise visits heavily with school funds to ensure you are only asked to contribute £5.
	We endeavour to keep our offer interesting and exciting but funding sometimes drives the changes that we need to make. We are
	exploring a residential visit for Year 6 next academic year (for current Year 5 children) and have still allocated almost £35,000 to continue
	visiting places regularly. As we know, costs have risen and this has impacted on businesses too; therefore, we are hit by price rises when
	we book something or somewhere. We will always ensure that the budget is carefully managed to ensure the children's experience of
	school is the best that it can be.
